

Interested in Gender Equity and Advocacy Efforts?

The Women's Sports Foundation®, a national non-profit 501(c)3 organization, is accepting online applications for full time Advocacy internship position for *January-June 2010*. Responsibilities include working with our Information Referral Service and assignment in the **Advocacy** department under the direction of an individual supervisor. Interns receive an hourly rate of \$7.25. Interns work in our Washington DC office for the hours of 9am-5pm, Monday through Friday. Interns may also obtain college credit along with the stipend.

The Advocacy Intern responds to all telephone, mail and e-mail requests for information related to Title IX, the Amateur Sports Act and other gender equity situations in women's sports. Daily interaction with parents, coaches and athletes confronting gender discrimination makes this experience both exciting and rewarding. Responses require familiarity with gender equity educational resources, and familiarity with Foundation listings of referral attorneys and agencies. Independent advocacy projects include preparing articles for the Foundation's newsletter, development of correspondence to encourage schools and organizations to comply with various laws, preparing documents for Congressional briefings, attending lobbying visits, researching gender equity topics and producing monthly advocacy reports.
