The Women's Sports Foundation®, a national nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, is accepting online applications for a part-time Public Policy internship position for sessions running June-August 2009, August-December and January-May. Responsibilities include working with Public Policy Department on its legislative initiatives and on gender equity cases. Interns will be under the direction of the Foundation's Public Policy Director. Interns work in the Foundation's D.C.-area office (Bethesda, Md.) 9 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday through Friday. The intern position is non-paid, but participants may obtain college/university credit.
